



Performance Driving and Autocross School April 24th & 28th, 2018

The Boeing Employees' Autosports Club (BEAC*) will present a Performance Driving and Autocross School 4/24 and 4/28. Required classroom session will be held the evening of Tuesday April 24th and an instructed driving practice will be held Saturday April 28th, all day.

- 4/28 onsite one-on-one driving instructor time and hands-on driving practice at the Shelton Airport (Sanderson Field). Check-in @ 9 am. Finish @ 5:00 pm.

Participation in the school is limited to persons who are eligible to be members of a Boeing Recreation club; Boeing employees, Boeing retirees, vendors, customers, contract, and government personnel assigned full time to The Boeing Company and their spouses and dependents. **"Autocross" is a medium-speed, non-wheel-to-wheel form of motorsports competition in which each car is individually timed through a course laid out on a large paved area using plastic traffic cones. It's conceptually similar to slalom skiing competition. Average speeds are in the low 40's (mph), top speeds typically are no more than 60-65.
